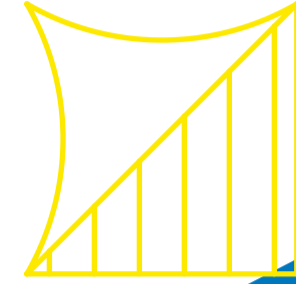

2. Place tamperproof bait stations every 5-10 metres apart where there are signs of rodent activity and in areas where rodents would feel safe and not exposed
3. Place 60g of SAPPHIRE Paste into each of the bait stations
4. Check the bait 5-7 days after the first treatment and replenish any bait taken
5. Search for, remove and dispose of any dead rodents found.

User category: For general public use.
Field of use: Indoor use for mice and rats / outdoor around buildings for rats only.
Application method: Ready to use bait to be used in tamper proof bait stations.
Tamper-resistant bait stations: Strong enough to prevent entry or destruction by dogs.
Strong enough to prevent entry or destruction by children under the age of 10 using hands, feet or objects reasonably expected to be available in the use area (e.g. sticks, stones, household objects, toys etc). Lockable or sealable so that children and dogs cannot gain access through the opening or mechanisms used to fill the bait compartments.
Do not get on face.
Resistant to destruction or weakening from exposure to typical non-catastrophic weather (e.g. direct sunlight, extremes of temperature and humidity, rain, snow etc).
Target organisms: *Rattus norvegicus* Brown Rat; *Mus musculus* House mouse; *Rattus rattus* Black or roof rat.

Application rates and methods
For rats: 60 g of bait per bait station. If more than one bait station is needed, the minimum distance between bait stations should be 3 – 10 m apart.
For mice: 10 g of bait per bait station. If more than 1 bait station is needed, the minimum distance between bait stations should be 3 – 5 m apart.

Instructions for use: Read and follow the product information as well as any information accompanying the product or provided at the point of sale before using it. Prior to the use of rodenticide products, non-chemical control methods (e.g. traps) should be considered. Remove food which is readily available for rodents (e.g. spilled grain or food wastes). Apart from this, do not clean up the infested area just before the treatment, as this only disturbs the rodent population and makes bait acceptance more difficult for rodents. Bait stations should be placed in the immediate vicinity where rodent activity has been observed (e.g. travel paths, nesting sites, foodstuffs, holes, burrows etc.). Where possible, bait stations must be fixed to the ground or other structures. Do not open the sachets containing the bait. Place bait stations out of the reach of children, baby, pets, farm animals and other non-target animals. Place bait stations away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs, as well as from utensils or surfaces that have contact with these. Do not place bait stations near water drainage systems where they can come into contact with water. When using the product do not eat, drink or smoke. Wash hands and directly exposed skin after using the product. Remove the remaining bait or the bait stations at the end of the treatment period.

Use specific instructions for use
Mice: The bait stations should be washed at least every 2 to 3 days at the beginning of the treatment and at least weekly afterwards, in order to check whether the bait is accepted. The bait stations are intact and to remove rodent bodies. Re fill bait when necessary.
Rats: The bait stations should be washed only 5 to 7 days after the beginning of the treatment and at least weekly afterwards, in order to check whether the bait is accepted. The bait stations are intact and to remove rodent bodies. Re fill bait when necessary.
Place the bait stations in areas non-toxic to humans. Replace any bait in a bait station in which bait has been damaged by water or contaminated by dirt.

Risk mitigation measures
Consider preventive control measures (plug holes, remove potential food and drinking as far as possible to improve product intake and reduce the likelihood of re-infestation) or to detect rodent activity. Using this product should eliminate rodents within 35 days. The product information (i.e. these labels) should clearly recommend that in case of suspected lack of efficacy by the end of the treatment (i.e. rodent activity is still observed), the user should seek advice from the product supplier or call a pest control service. Search for and remove dead rodents during treatment, at least as often as baiting stations are inspected. Dispose dead rodents in accordance with local requirements. Because of their design mode of action, anticoagulant rodenticides take from 4 to 10 days to be effective after consumption of the bait. Rodents can be disease carriers. Do not touch dead rodents with bare hands, use gloves or use tools such as tongs when disposing them. This product contains a bittering agent and a dye. In the UK and Ireland, poisoned rodents should be double bagged using plastic bags and either disposed of in a household waste bin with a secure lid to prevent access of wildlife or pets or collected by a specialist waste contractor or the local authority.

Use lockable and sealable. It is illegal to use this product for uses or in a manner other than prescribed on this label. For information or to report a poisoning incident contact The National Poisons Information Centre, Beaumont Hospital, Dublin (01-809-2100), retain the label for reference.

Warning

Instructions for safe disposal of the product and its packaging
At the end of the treatment, remove unopened bait and the packaging in accordance with local requirements. UK only: In the UK waste bait should be double bagged in plastic bags and disposed of in a household waste bin with a secure lid to prevent access of wildlife or pets or taken to a civic amenity site. For information on civic amenity sites contact the local authority. Ireland only: At the end of the treatment, dispose of sachets/bait and the packaging in accordance with EPA requirements for the disposal of hazardous waste. Use of gloves is recommended. Where control of rodents has not been achieved by a control program after 35 days, the user should seek advice from the product supplier or call a pest control service. Do not use this product for treatment of public buildings. Poisoned rodents should be double-bagged using plastic bags and either disposed of in a household waste bin with a secure lid to prevent access of wildlife or pets or collected by a specialist waste contractor.

Particulars of likely direct or indirect effects, first aid instructions and emergency measures to protect the environment
This product contains an anticoagulant substance. If ingested, symptoms, which may be delayed, may include weakness and bleeding gums. In severe cases, there may be bruising and blood present in the faeces or urine. Antidote: Vitamin K1 administered by medical/veterinary personnel only in case of animal exposure, wash skin with water and then with water and soap. Eye exposure: rinse eyes with eye-rinse liquid or water, keep eyes lids open at least 10 minutes. Oral exposure: rinse mouth carefully with water, never give anything by mouth to unconscious person. Do not provoke vomiting. If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately and show the product's container or label. UK only: UK medical professionals should contact the National Poisons Information Service (www.npis.org) for further advice. Contact a veterinary surgeon in case of ingestion by a pet. Bait stations must be labelled with the following information: "do not move or open", "contains a rodenticide", "product name or authorisation number", "active substances" and "in case of accident, call a poison centre. Hazardous to wildlife".

Conditions of storage and shelf life of the product under normal conditions of storage
Store in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place. Keep the container closed and away from direct sunlight. Store in places prevented from the access of children, birds, pets and farm animals. Shelf life: 2 years.
